Teacher Induction in California. California has a two-tiered credentialing system for teachers. Preliminary programs prepare candidates to obtain an initial teaching credential through successful completion of required coursework, fieldwork, and a performance demonstration of their knowledge, skills, and abilities.

California Teacher Induction

Under the Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA) and the Ontario Business Corporations Act, members of the College may establish a Health Profession Corporation, provided they obtain a Certificate of Authorization from the College.. This provision is intended to level the playing field for all health professionals, some of whom had previously been able to benefit from some tax relief.
